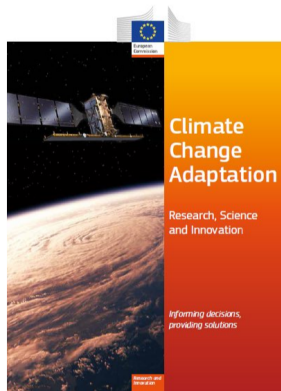
ABOUT US / **COACCH public deliverables on website**

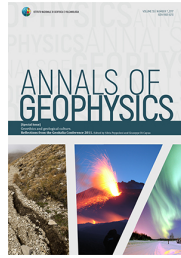
EVENTS / COACCH @GREEN-WIN, TRANSrisk & CD-LINKS Joint Policy Day

PUBLICATION / "Extreme precipitation events over north-western Europe: getting water from the tropics"



A better understanding of the North Atlantic atmospheric conditions prior the occurrence of extreme precipitation events over Europe could help in improving our capability to predict them. Authors build on atmospheric re-analyses at high spatial resolution (such as JRA-55 and MERRA) to highlight the anomalous path of the vertically integrated water content.
