A key focus of the COACCH project (**CO**-designing the **A**ssessment of **C**limate **C**hange costs) is to proactively involve stakeholders in the design and delivery of research, as part of a collaborative co-production process. The project recognises that end-user needs and interests vary, and so engages with a wide range of representatives from policy, business and industry, investment, research and civil society. COACCH is using interactive workshops to co-design the project's direction, activities and outputs.

The first and second co-design workshop in 2018 and 2019 produced key insights to guide the COACCH project. In this third workshop, the research team will present recent findings and we will jointly explore ideas for the last phase of work.

The objectives of the third interactive workshop are to:

- Present and discuss interim results on assessment of tipping points and macroeconomic assessment;
- Gather feedback on COACCH outputs such as web-based scenario explorer;
- Discuss and collect inputs for upcoming work on policy assessment.
